Congress is considering "Fast Track" legislation that will make it easier to pass more bad trade deals. That means more American jobs shipped overseas.

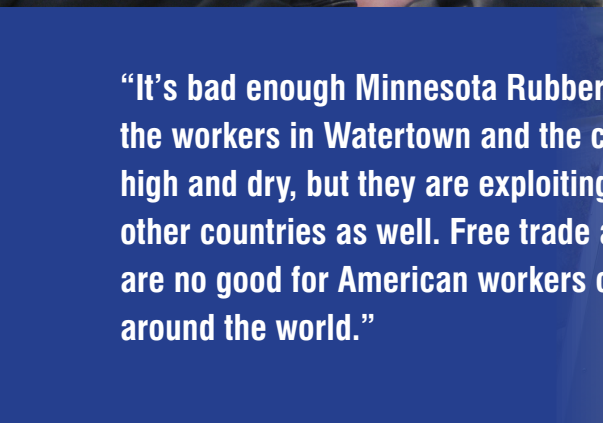
It's time to fight back. We need to Stop Fast Track and demand fair trade deals that keep jobs in America.
