

Scholarship: Another IAM Helping Hand

Are you putting a child through college or paying for them to attend a vocational-technical school? Are you anticipating this critical expense and watching tuition rise every year? Or, are you are trying to further your own education? Well, the IAM is here to help.

Back in 1960, the delegates to the IAM Grand Lodge Convention voted to establish a <u>Scholarship Competition</u> and the program has grown ever since. The competition is open each year to members of the IAM and their children throughout the United States and Canada. Awards to members are \$2,000 per academic year. They are granted for a specific period from one to four years to enable the member to earn a Bachelor's degree or a two-year vocational-technical certification.

Awards to the children of members are, for college students, \$1,000 per academic year and renewed each year until a Bachelor's degree is obtained up to a maximum of four years. And, for vocational-technical school students, \$2,000 per year until certification is reached up to a maximum of two years.

The IAM Scholarship Competition is just one more way that the IAM helps families help themselves. We are a union that recognizes *all* the dimensions of a fulfilling life, not just wages and benefits. Join the IAM and you get the whole package.
