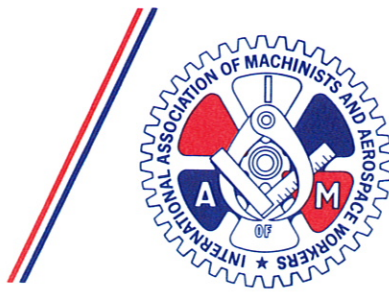

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

This communication shall serve as the official call to the IAM's First International Human Rights Conference. The conference will take place beginning Thursday, September 1st and conclude by 12:00 noon on Monday September 5, 2011. Registration will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. on September 1st.

The conference will take place at the Buena Vista Palace Hotel and Spa, at 1900 Buena Vista Drive, Lake Buena Vista, FL 32830. The conference hotel is located within the Walt Disney Resort. Reservations may be secured by calling the hotel directly at 1-866-246-6563. **A special discounted rate of \$109 plus tax per night, single or double occupancy, has been arranged. To ensure you receive the special rate, please identify yourself as being with the IAMAW Machinists Human Rights Conference. The block of rooms is limited, and reservations must be made by August 1, 2011, to qualify for the discounted rate.**

For advanced planning purposes, it is imperative participants register with IAM Headquarters. Discounted registration fees are available if form and payment are received by deadlines described on the enclosed registration form.
