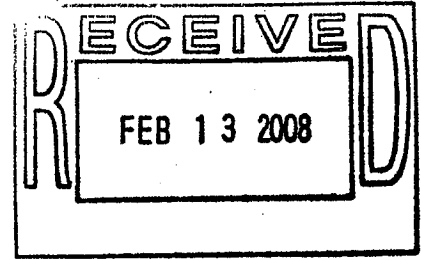

PETITIONER'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW


The Petitioner moves to withdraw from the appeal and requests the matter be closed:


