Against Cargo Preference Standards

Voted 7 times against cargo preference standards for the U.S. Merchant Marine—America's fourth line of defense

- 1996: Voted to force U.S. vessels to charge third world rates [S. Amdt. 5393 to H.R. 1350, Vote # 298, 11/24/96]
- 1993: Voted twice to ban U.S.-flag ships that charge more than third world competitors [S. Amdt 1019 to H.R. 2750, Vote #304, 10/5/93; S. Amdt. 497 to H.R. 2118, Vote #162, 6/22/93]
- 1991: After moving troops and critical supplies during the Gulf War, McCain opposed increasing the number of U.S.-flag ships and jobs [S. Amdt. 822 to S. 1455, Vote #146, 7/24/91]

Against Cargo Preference Standards

Voted 7 times against cargo preference standards for the U.S. Merchant Marine—America's fourth line of defense

- 1990:Voted to gut cargo preference standards twice, including for agricultural trade [S. Amdt. 2425 to S.2830, Vote #186, 7/27/90; S.Amdt. 2338 to S. 2830, Vote # 169, 7/24/90]
- 1989: Voted to strip military and foreign aid shipments from U.S. crewed vessels—undermining the merchant marine's role [S. Amdt 796 to H.R. 2939, Vote #193, 9/20/89]

McCain Weakens Maritime Security

McCain Against Port Security—Even After 9/11

- Against \$1.7 billion for the Coast Guard and port security [S. Amdt. 3034 to S.Con.Res. 83, Vote #59, 3/16/06]
- Opposed \$965 million to fund anti-terror programs for ports, including strengthening port inspections [S. Amdt. 3054 to S.Con.Res. 83, Vote #47, 3/15/06]

McCain Fights to Offshore American Jobs

- At McCain's urging, the Defense Department awarded a \$35 billion contract in 2008 to EADS-Airbus, a foreign airplane builder
- The deal will eliminate 44,000 American jobs [Matthew Daly "Boeing Supporters Target McCain over Tanker Loss," Associated Press, 3/8/08]
