McCain Against Transit Labor Rights

- Transit workers' labor rights have been protected for 43 years by a law referred to as "13(c)"
- 13(c) labor protections are among America's strongest protections for workers—defending bargaining, pensions, safety, and ensuring employment for transit workers

McCain Against Transit Labor Rights

• McCain voted against 13(c) labor rights [Gramm Amdt. to H.R. 2,

 This attack on workers endangers the rights of over 320,000 urban, rural, and suburban transit employees
