- McCain voted to gut rail and transit workers' bargaining rights.
- McCain stands against security funds to protect rail workers: In 2006 he opposed rail anti-terrorism program funding of \$1.1 billion.
- McCain endangered thousands of railroad jobs by voting 9 times against funding for Amtrak and freight railroads.
- McCain calls Amtrak a “scam” and says Amtrak should be restructured to eliminate its reliance on the American taxpayers and to allow for its privatization.
- McCain supports tax breaks for companies that ship jobs overseas and voted to weaken Buy American laws which keep critical jobs in the U.S.: “I firmly object to Buy American provisions...,” he said in 2005.
- McCain voted to kill the Employee Free Choice Act. He also supported a Republican bill which would have created a national (so-called) Right to Work law which would essentially have gutted unions across America.
- McCain has backed companies that fire or replace lawfully striking workers and voted for legislation that would have allowed scabs to permanently replace workers who were forced out on strike. He supports using bankruptcy to destroy union contracts.
