#### Health-Related Assistance

- If you need to file for bankruptcy, you can take the required bankruptcy
  counseling through <u>Union Plus Credit Counseling</u> and the usual \$50 filing fee

# Union Plus Credit Cardholders are eligible for special assistance

- If you are out of work at least 90 days within the last 6 months, you can apply for \$250 through the Union SAFE Job Loss Grant.
- You may also be eligible to skip two credit card payments a
  year. If you find you will be late making a payment or want to
  take advantage of the skip payment, call the Union Plus
  Credit Card at 1-800-622-2580 before your payment is due to
  see if you qualify.
- If you are on a prolonged strike or lock-out, you may be eligible for the special Strike Skip Pay where you can skip up to 4 months per year, 3 of them consecutively. Call 1-800-622-2580.

## UnionSecure term life insurance policyholders

 If you are unemployed for 30 days or more, you can have your UnionSecure life insurance premium payment waived for up to three months. Call UnionSecure at 1-800-393-0864 for details and to set up your payment waiver.
