

#### Dear Sisters and Brothers:

A fundamental objective of the IAM Women's and Human Rights Department's mission is to seize every opportunity to forward the goal of ensuring a discrimination and harassment free workplace as we bring women's and human rights issues to the forefront. An efficient way to accomplish this goal is to partner with like minded organizations such as the AFL-CIO Constituency Groups, as well as other women's, civil and human rights driven associations.

To that end, the IAM has forged strong alliances with groups such as the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists (CBTU), the Asian Pacific American Labor Alliance (APALA), the Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA) and the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW), to name a few.

The current economic situation and recent changes in the political arena make now an opportune time to pull together and unite our voices in the best interest of working families. This year marks CLUW's 15<sup>th</sup> Biennial Convention, which is themed *The Rising Tide of Change:* Activism, Leadership – Union Women! Their agenda will include speakers, workshops and panel discussions aimed at promoting networking, information sharing and idea developing that will strengthen the labor movement and nurture the women union leaders of the future.

The IAM will not host a 2009 Women's Conference to allow our IAM sisters and brothers to fully participate in the CLUW Convention. Therefore, I wholeheartedly encourage all lodges to take this opportunity to send any interested members to attend this convention scheduled from October 14-17, 2009, in Los Angeles, California. The IAM has always held the distinction of sending a large delegation to the CLUW Convention and I would like to see that tradition continue, especially since elections for National Executive Board members will be held this year.

In compliance with the CLUW Constitution, registrants for the CLUW convention must be a member in good standing of the National CLUW organization (membership application attached). The registration fee for the CLUW Convention is \$200 if you submit it before September 4, 2009 (\$75 for retirees). Registrations received after September 4<sup>th</sup> will incur an addition \$25 late fee. Your registration fee covers attendance to the convention, one ticket to the gala reception, a convention kit, convention t-shirt, educational materials and workshops. All financial costs associated with the convention are the responsibility of the lodge. **Registration** fees should be paid with checks made payable to CLUW and sent to the IAM Women's and Human Rights Department at IAM Headquarters using the attached registration forms.

A block of rooms under the group name Coalition of Labor Union Women/CLUW has been reserved at a special room rate of \$145 plus applicable taxes, single or double occupancy on a first come-first served basis **until September 10, 2009** at the Westin Bonaventure Hotel & Suites, located at 404 South Figueroa Street, Los Angeles, CA 90071. Reservations made after the cut-off date will be subject to hotel availability and prevailing standard rate. Please call the Westin Bonaventure toll free at 1-800-WESTIN-1 (1-800-937-8461) to make your reservation as soon as possible. Online reservations can be made through the CLUW website at <a href="www.cluw.org">www.cluw.org</a>. **Be advised that your lodge will be responsible for paying any fee charged by the hotel if your delegate(s) is a "no-show," or if the reservation is not cancelled in a timely manner.** 

To help plan your arrival and departure to Los Angeles, please note the hotel check-in time is 3:00 p.m. and check-out time is 12:00 noon. The hotel bell staff can arrange to check baggage for those arriving early when rooms are not yet available and for participants attending the last day of the convention prior to departure.


