The 2011 AFL-CIO Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Holiday Observance will be held January 13-17 in Cincinnati, Ohio. Cincinnati has a rich civil rights history. It is just steps from the banks of the Ohio River, which served as a natural dividing line between the slave states of the South and the free states of the North. As such, it served as one of the last stops on the Underground Railroad.

As in past years, we will commit one day to community service projects so bring your work clothes. We will also have an education day, with speakers and workshops. A detailed agenda for the conference will be available at a later date.
