

Don't wait! Florida Early Voting begins October 27th!



In Florida, you don't have to wait until **Election Day, November 6th**, to cast your ballot—you can vote early! Anyone registered in the state of Florida is eligible to participate in early voting, regardless of what county you live in. Traditional Early Voting begins on **Saturday, October 27th**, and ends on **Saturday, November 3rd**. Early Voting is also available **Sunday, October 28**.

- Florida Driver's License;
- Florida identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles;
- United States passport;
- Debit or credit card;
- Military identification;
- Student identification;
- Retirement center identification;
- Neighborhood association identification;
- Public assistance identification.
