# IAM Members Elect National Leaders

IAM members in the United States and Canada have elected national leaders to four-year terms commencing on July 1, 2013.

Every four years, IAM members nominate their national officers at the last (or only) regular Local Lodge meeting held during the month of January. Candidates are nominated for International President, General Secretary-Treasurer, nine General Vice Presidents, five members of the Committee on Law, three Delegates to the AFL-CIO and one Delegate to the Canadian Labour Congress.

To be officially nominated under the provisions of the IAM Constitution, a candidate for office must receive endorsements from at least 25 Local Lodges (20 for the General Vice President nominated by Local Lodges in Canada).

The candidates below received the required number of Local Lodge endorsements. Because no other candidates received the minimum number of endorsements, these candidates are thus elected to their respective offices.

Officers nominated and elected are:

**International President:** R. Thomas Buffenbarger, Local Lodge 912, re-elected.

**General Secretary-Treasurer:** Robert Roach, Jr., Local Lodge 1445, nominated and elected after being appointed General Secretary-Treasurer in 2012.

**General Vice Presidents:** Dave Ritchie, Local Lodge 235; Lynn Tucker, Jr., Local Lodge

2312; Robert Martinez, Jr., Local Lodge 776A; Philip Gruber, Local Lodge 688 and Gary Allen, Local Lodge 794, were re-elected as General Vice Presidents. Sito Pantoja, Local Lodge 949 and Mark Blondin, Local Lodge 751C were nominated and elected after being appointed General Vice Presidents in 2012. Diane Babineaux, Grand Lodge and Dora Cervantes, Local Lodge 2198, were nominated and elected for the first time.

## **Members of the Committee on Law:**

Philip Zannella, Jr., Local Lodge 1363; James Beno, Local Lodge 2182; Stan Pickthall, Local Lodge 692 and Ellen Arbogast, Local Lodge 1345, were re-elected. Jeffrey Doerr, Local Lodge 112, was nominated and elected after being appointed in 2009.

**Delegates to the AFL-CIO:** Shelley Kessler, Local Lodge 1414 and James Conigliaro, Local Lodge 447, were re-elected. Rickey Wallace, Local Lodge 1296, was nominated and elected for the first time.

## **Delegate to the Canadian Labour**

**Congress:** Tania Canniff, Local Lodge 764, was nominated and elected for the first time.

R. Thomas Buffenbarger is the 13th International President in IAM history, first elected to the post in 1997. As International

President, he holds the highest office in the IAM.

The son of an IAM member, Buffenbarger accepted his first leadership role in 1970, at age 20, when he was elected Shop Steward of his apprenticeship group at General Electric Jet Engines, IAM Local Lodge 912 in Evendale, Ohio.

Seven years later, Buffenbarger was elected Business Representative for District Lodge 34 in Cincinnati. In 1980, he was appointed Special Representative for the IAM's former Great Lakes Territory, and three years later became Administrative Assistant to that Territory's General Vice President.

Buffenbarger came to IAM

Headquarters in 1986 to work in the Organizing Department. Two years later, he was chosen by International President William W. Winpisinger to serve as his Executive Assistant. Buffenbarger continued to serve in that capacity with the next International President, George J. Kourpias.

From 1991 until his own election as International President in 1997, Buffenbarger served as the General Vice President at IAM Headquarters, functioning as chief of staff of Headquarters operations.

As IAM International President, Buffenbarger also serves as a member of the AFL-CIO Executive Council and as Vice President of the IndustriALL Global Union.



Robert Roach, Jr. has served as the IAM's General Secretary-Treasurer since 2012. He is the 11th in IAM history and the first African-American. The General Secretary-Treasurer directs the financial operations of the International Union and ensures the IAM remains one of the most financially sound unions in North America.

Roach started with the IAM in 1975 as a member of New York Local Lodge 1056 working as a Ramp Serviceman for TWA. Soon after, he transferred to Local 1445 in Newark,

NJ. He was elected Shop Steward in 1976, and served as Grievance Committee Chairman from 1979 through 1992. Roach held other union positions in Local 1445, including Trustee, Vice President and President.

In 1984, Roach was elected District Lodge 142 Trustee and also served as Coordinator for the District's Human Rights Committee. Roach became a District 142 General Chairman in 1992.

Roach was appointed Special Representative for the IAM's Transportation Department in 1994 and was soon promoted to Grand Lodge Representative. In 1999, Roach became Transportation General Vice President and was re-elected repeatedly until becoming General Secretary-Treasurer in 2012.

As the Transportation General Vice President, Roach regularly testified before Congress on aviation matters including aircraft maintenance oversight, aviation safety and security, bankruptcy reform, employee pensions, industry consolidation and the state of the airline industry. He served as a member of

the International Transport Workers' Federation Executive Board and Management Committee for over 12 years.

Roach has also served as a member of the Executive Committee of the AFL-CIO's Transportation Trades Department, the Executive Board of the AFL-CIO's Maritime Trades Department and Trustee to the IAM National Pension Fund.

On January 1, 2012, Roach was appointed IAM General Secretary-Treasurer. He also serves as Co-Chairperson of the IAM National Pension Fund and the National IAM Benefit Trust Fund. In addition, Roach serves on the boards of both the AFL-CIO Union Label & Service Trades Department and Union Privilege. He is a Labor Advisory Board Member of American Income Life.

Roach holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Labor and Management Relations from the Empire State Labor College and is a graduate of the Labor Studies and Arbitration and Essentials of Conflict Resolution programs at the Cornell University School of Industrial and Labor Relations.



Dave Ritchie has served as the IAM General Vice President for Canada since 1995. Ritchie coordinates the administration of services for 40,000 Canadian IAM members and leads the IAM's legislative fight and organizing campaigns in all of the Canadian provinces; which include Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Newfoundland-Labrador, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Quebec and Saskatchewan, as well as the Yukon, Northwest and Nunavut Territories.

A forty-year member of the IAM, Ritchie brings the talents of a sea-

sioned negotiator, skilled organizer, political activist and experienced administrator to the position of IAM Canadian Vice President. After joining the IAM Executive Council in 1995, Ritchie was re-elected in 1997, 2001, 2005 and 2009.

Ritchie joined Toronto IAM Local Lodge 1755 in 1973 when Sangamo Electric hired him as an electric meter repairperson. He is now a member of Local 235 following its merger with Local 1755. Immediately upon joining the IAM, Ritchie became active in his union and held numerous positions, including Shop Steward, Chief Steward, Shop Committee Chairperson, Vice President and Negotiating Committee Chairperson.

In 1978, Ritchie was elected Business Representative for District Lodge 78, performing a wide variety of duties including Vice President and President. He is a founding member of the Canadian Conference of Machinists and has served as Vice President of the Ontario Council of Machinists.

Serving as District 78 Directing

Business Representative from 1986 to 1995, Ritchie administered the activities of one of the largest IAM districts in Canada whose members work in the manufacturing, hospitality, and health care sectors.

Ritchie is the past Chairperson of the Ontario Newspaper Council of Unions. His interests in apprenticeship programs led him to membership on the Ontario Premier's Council for Apprenticeships. He also served as an Executive Board Member for Electronic Sector Skills Ontario and Co-Chair of the Apprenticeship Committee Sectorial Skills.

As senior officer of the IAM in Canada, Ritchie also serves as a Vice President on the Executive Committee of the Canadian Labour Congress and is Co-Chair of the Canadian IAM Labour-Management Pension Fund.

An avid supporter of Guide Dogs of America, the Dave Ritchie Invitational Golf Tournament has been held each year in Toronto since 1997, raising, on average, more than \$30,000 annually for the IAM's official charity.



Lynn Tucker, Jr., has served as the IAM General Vice President assigned to the Eastern Territory since 2003. The Eastern Territory includes the District of Columbia and fourteen states: Connecticut, Delaware, Massachusetts, Maryland, Maine, Michigan, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylva-

nia, Rhode Island, West Virginia and Vermont.

Tucker began his career with the Machinists Union in 1976 working for Miller Brewery in Fulton, NY. He has held a variety of elected offices in the IAM including Shop Steward, Senior Steward, Local Lodge Vice President and President. Tucker also served on the Oswego New York Labor Council, the Greater Syracuse New York Labor Council and was Vice President of the New York State Council of Machinists. He has served as Director of the United Way in Fulton, NY, and as President of the Industrial Relations Research Association, Central New York Chapter, Syracuse, NY. Tucker is also a member of the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW), the National Association for the Advancement of

Colored People (NAACP) and the A. Philip Randolph Institute (APRI).

In 1986, Tucker was elected as a Business Representative for District Lodge 137 in Watertown, NY. In 1989, Tucker was appointed by International President George Kourpias as a Special Representative for the Eastern Territory and advanced to the position of Grand Lodge Representative. In 1992, Eastern Territory General Vice President George J. Poulin selected Tucker to serve as his Administrative Assistant. When Poulin retired in 1997, newly-elected General Vice President Warren Mart selected Tucker to continue as the Eastern Territory Administrative Assistant. Tucker served as Administrative Assistant until 2003 when he became the General Vice President for the Eastern Territory.



Robert Martinez, Jr., has served as the General Vice President assigned to the Southern Territory since 2003. The Southern Territory includes fourteen states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia, as well as Puerto Rico, Panama and the Virgin Islands.

Martinez, a United States Navy Veteran, joined Local Lodge 776A,

Aeronautical Industrial District Lodge 776, in Fort Worth, TX, in 1980 as an Aircraft Assembler at Lockheed Martin Aeronautics Fort Worth Division. He served on many committees and in various positions with his local lodge throughout his employment at Lockheed.

In 1994, Martinez was assigned to the International Chemical Workers Union Center for Worker Safety and Health Education in Cincinnati, OH, as the IAM's liaison to this Federal Consortium of Education. He was assigned in 1995 to serve in the IAM Safety and Health Department. He also served as a Project Coordinator for the Corporation for Re-Employment and Safety Training (IAM CREST) and for the Center for Administering Rehabilitation and Employment Services (IAM CARES).

In 1999, with the addition of the Grand Lodge Territorial Education Representatives, International

President Tom Buffenbarger assigned Martinez to serve as the Southern Territory Education Representative in Dallas, TX. In April 2002, he was re-assigned as a Special Representative and served in that capacity until assuming the office of Southern Territory General Vice President in July 2003.

In addition to serving on the IAM Executive Council, Martinez is on the Board of Directors for Guide Dogs of America, a Trustee on the Board of the IAM National Pension Fund, a National Vice President on the National Executive Board of the Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA) and on the Board of Directors with the Texas Labor-Management Conference.

Martinez served on the Democratic National Committee on the Hispanic and Southern Caucuses and he now serves on several business and labor advisory groups.



Philip Gruber has served as the IAM General Vice President assigned to the Midwest Territory since 2006. The Midwest Territory is comprised of nine states: Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan.

Gruber has been a member of the Machinists Union since his

initiation into Local Lodge 688 in St. Louis, MO, in 1972 when he began his apprenticeship. He became a Journeyman Tool & Die Maker in 1976. He served as Steward, Chief Steward, Treasurer and President of Local 688. He was elected delegate to the St. Louis Labor Council, the Missouri State Council of Machinists and the IAM National Tool & Die Conference.

In 1976, Gruber taught the Apprenticeship Program for Belleville Area College and in 1977, he taught the Apprenticeship Program for Lewis and Clark College. In 1978, he helped rewrite the Apprenticeship Program that is still in use today.

Gruber has served as Secretary-Treasurer, then President of the District 9/PAC and the Missouri State Council of Machinists. He also has served as Secretary-Treasurer of

the Midwest States Conference of Machinists, the National Tool and Die Conference and as Chairman of the District 9 Joint Apprenticeship Committee. Gruber was a member of the National Planning Committee, the IAM Law Committee and the Board of Directors of United Way of St. Louis. Gruber still serves on the Board of Directors for Guide Dogs of America and the Illinois Workers Compensation Advisory Board.

In 1987, Gruber joined the staff of District Lodge 9 in St. Louis, MO as a Business Representative. In 1996, he was appointed the Assistant Directing Business Representative of District 9. He became the Directing Business Representative in 2003.

In 2004, Midwest Territory General Vice President James E. Brown appointed Gruber as Administrative Assistant. In 2006, Gruber succeeded Brown as General Vice President.



Gary Allen has served as the General Vice President assigned to the Western Territory since 2009. The Western Territory includes thirteen states: Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico, Nevada, Oregon, Utah, Washington and Wyoming.

Allen brings a broad depth and breadth of experience in numerous industries, from aerospace to automotive, as well as in organizing, servicing, and representation. He initiated into IAM Local Lodge 794 in 1979, when he was hired at the

General Electric Aircraft Engine Plant in Albuquerque, NM.

Following his father's example, Allen involved himself in the IAM very early. He was elected Area Steward in 1981. A year later he was elected First Shift Steward and by 1983 he was elected Chief Steward, overseeing the activities of all Shop Stewards on all shifts at General Electric. Allen also served as Local Lodge Auditor, Labor Relations Negotiating Committee member, Organizing Committee member, and as a delegate to former District Lodge 183.

In 1985, at the age of 24, Allen became President and Directing Business Representative of Local Lodge 794, representing members at a variety of shops including General Electric, Greyhound, Fruehauf Trailers and Arkansas Best Freight.

In 1989, Allen was appointed Special Representative for the Western Territory and became a Grand Lodge Representative in 1991. In 1996 he was appointed Territorial Organizing Leader where he coordinated the organizing activities

throughout the Western Territory. Allen moved to IAM Headquarters in 1997 as a Coordinator for the Collective Bargaining Department and later that year was appointed Aerospace Coordinator in the newly-formed IAM Aerospace Department. Allen coordinated collective bargaining throughout North America with aerospace companies such as General Electric, Rolls-Royce, Pratt & Whitney, Hamilton Sundstrand and Raytheon, among others.

In 2003, Allen was appointed as the Western Territory's Administrative Assistant and was elected General Vice President of the Western Territory in 2009.

Since 2012, Allen has represented the IAM as a trustee on the IAM National Pension Fund, the sixth largest multiemployer pension fund in the United States.

Allen has also served his community as an Executive Board member for the Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA) since 1991 and as a Vice President since 2010.



Sito Pantoja has served as the IAM General Vice President assigned to Transportation since January 2012. The Transportation Department operates from IAM Headquarters and administers contracts in the railroad and air transport sectors in the United States.

Pantoja initiated into IAM Local Lodge 1056 in Jamaica, NY, in 1977

as an Aircraft & Powerplant Mechanic for TWA. He served as a Shop Steward for Local 1056 until he transferred to Local Lodge 949 in St. Louis, MO in 1988. At Local 949, Pantoja served as a Trustee and Recording Secretary; and, in 1991, as member and later Chairman of the local's Full-Time Grievance Committee.

Appointed as a Transportation Department Special Representative in 1999 and Grand Lodge Representative shortly thereafter, Pantoja was chosen by Transportation General Vice President Robert Roach, Jr., to serve as Administrative Assistant in 2005 where he served until becoming Transportation General Vice President in 2012.

After becoming Transportation General Vice President, International President Tom Buffenbarger appointed Pantoja as the IAM's representative

on the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Aviation Rulemaking Advisory Committee (ARAC). The ARAC provides advice and recommendations to the FAA on rulemaking activity, such as aircraft operations, airmen and air agency certification and airworthiness standards.

Also in 2012, Pantoja was elected to serve on the Executive Board of the International Transport Workers' Federation (ITF) headquartered in London, England. Pantoja has also served as Chairman of the ITF's Civil Aviation Section Committee since 2010. The ITF is a global federation of transportation unions representing millions of transportation workers around the world.

A graduate of New York City's Aviation High School, Pantoja also holds a Bachelor's Degree in Labor Studies from the National Labor College.



Mark Blondin has served as the General Vice President assigned to the Aerospace Territory since 2012. Blondin's IAM career started in 1978 while working at an IAM-represented machine shop in Seattle, WA. He hired on at the Boeing Company in 1979, and worked in the tooling department at the Renton facility.

Blondin held numerous Local 751C positions through the years, including Shop Steward, Auditor, Trustee, Financial Secretary, Recording Secretary, Vice President, and Local 751C Delegate to the District Council. Blondin has always been a champion for workplace health and safety and served for many years on the Renton Site Safety Committee.

In 1996, Blondin was elected as a Business Representative for District Lodge 751, and later elected President and Directing Business Representative in 2000. Blondin has been the chief IAM negotiator for Boeing contracts at District Lodge 751 since 2002. Blondin was also elected to the IAM Law Committee and served during the 2004 Grand Lodge Convention. In addition to serving as President and Directing Business Representative

at District 751, Blondin also held the position of Secretary-Treasurer of the Washington State Machinists Council.

Blondin was assigned as an IAM Aerospace Coordinator in 2007, with the primary responsibility of negotiating agreements between the IAM and Boeing throughout the United States and Canada. Blondin became the General Vice President assigned to the Aerospace Territory in 2012. As part of the restructuring of duties on the Executive Council, the Aerospace Territory will return to its status as the Aerospace Department within the Headquarters Territory.

Blondin assists the community as a Board Member and fundraiser for Guide Dogs of America, the Salvation Army and Families and Friends of Violent Crime Victims.



Diane Babineaux will join the IAM Executive Council as the first African-American woman to serve as a General Vice President. She has served as the Chief of Staff to the International President, formerly titled Executive Assistant, since 2000. Her assigned duties as General Vice President will include coordinating and administering the activities of several Departments at IAM Headquarters and continue promoting the IAM's mission to expand Women's and Human Rights.

Babineaux started her IAM

career in 1972 in the Legislative and Political Action Department. She then worked in the Research Department until 1996 when she was appointed Special Assistant to the International President.

In 2000, President Tom Buffenbarger named Babineaux as his Executive Assistant, the first woman in IAM history to serve in that capacity.

As Chief of Staff, Babineaux's duties included researching economic and political trends and responsibility for expense management and budgetary controls. In addition, Babineaux managed the Human Rights Department, the Women's Department and the Young Machinists Program. She was instrumental in holding the inaugural IAM Human Rights Conference in Orlando, FL, and the first Young Machinists Symposium in Toronto, Canada. She also worked closely with IndustriALL and other international trade union secretariats with whom the IAM is affiliated.

An active member of the Labor, Human Rights and African-American

communities, Babineaux has been recognized for her outstanding service and leadership by numerous organizations. She serves on the Board of Directors for Guide Dogs of America, is a Trustee for the Coalition of Black Trade Unionists (CBTU) and a member of their Women's Committee. She is on the Executive Board of the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW), the Board of the National Coalition of Black Civic Participation and the National Board of the A. Philip Randolph Institute (APRI).

Babineaux is also a member of the Asian Pacific American Labor Alliance (APALA), Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA), National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), Voter Participation Black Women's Roundtable, Conference of Minority Transportation Officials, National Action Network, National Council of Negro Women, National Democratic Club, National Urban League, Operation PUSH and Pride at Work.

Cervantes initiated into IAM Local Lodge 2198 in Houston, TX, in 1989 as a Reservations Agent for Southwest Airlines. She served in many capacities for her Local Lodge, including Organizer, Shop Steward, Recording Secretary and Vice President.

In 1999, Cervantes was chosen to serve as an Apprentice Organizer for Airline District Lodge 142, and became a General Chairperson for that District the following year. By appointment from International President Tom Buffenbarger, she served on the IAM's 2002 Blue Ribbon Commission.

In 2005, Cervantes was appointed to the Grand Lodge staff in the Transportation Department as a Special Representative, and was later promoted to Grand Lodge Representative. It was in July of 2012 when

Cervantes was selected by General Secretary-Treasurer Robert Roach, Jr., to serve as Assistant Secretary to the GST.

Cervantes currently serves as a National Board Member on the Labor Council for Latin American Advancement (LCLAA), is an active member of the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW) and serves on the Women's Committee of the International Transport Workers' Federation (ITF) headquartered in London, England.
