I write on behalf of my constituents, who are members of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM), to urge US Airways to conduct its negotiations with your current employees in the same spirit as you conducted negotiations with other work groups.

Negotiations between IAM members and US Airways have been going on for more than two years. My constituents are concerned that they will not get an equitable contract. Specifically, they are concerned that their new co-workers may achieve better salaries and benefits in the new company than they will. All my constituents want is what is fair, which an equitable contract and salaries and benefits on par with their new co-workers.

I urge you to bring a swift conclusion to these negotiations and to resolve this situation in a fair and equitable manner.
