We understand that US Airways is in collective bargaining negotiations with U.S. Airways' members of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM). We understand that US Airways has already negotiated wage rates and labor agreements with the American Airlines unions and the other U.S. Airways unions in light of the proposed US Airways-American Airlines merger. Not surprisingly, IAM has made clear to us that to gain its support for the merger of US Airways and American Airlines, IAM members must achieve wage parity with American Airlines employees in similar unionized classifications. We urge you to engage in good-faith bargaining and negotiations with IAM.
