ELECTION OF IAM OFFICERS

To: The Membership of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers

From: The Grand Lodge Election Tellers

Subject: The Election of IAM Officers for the Term Ending June 30, 2017

In accordance with Article III of the Constitution of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM), a secret ballot election was conducted at local lodge meetings during April 2014 for the offices of International President, General Secretary-Treasurer in the U.S. and Canada, and for eight (8) General Vice Presidents in the U.S.

The opposing candidates for International President each selected an IAM member to serve as the Grand Lodge Tellers in accordance with Article III, Section 15. Incumbent International President R. Thomas Buffenbarger chose Local Lodge 1916 Member Richard Michalski as his Teller, and challenger Jay Cronk chose Local Lodge 751A Member Mark Clark as his Teller. Tellers Michalski and Clark together chose Derrick E. Strosnider, a certified public accountant, as the third Teller and the Chairman of the Grand Lodge Election Tellers.

Ballots and other election records were mailed by the Local Lodge Inspectors of Election to the General Secretary-Treasurer and secured at the Grand Lodge until the counting of the votes beginning on May 7, 2014. Challenges were resolved and ballots were counted between May 7th and May 9th, and on May 21st in front of observers designated by the candidates in the election. 884 local lodges participated in the election and returned 34,758 valid ballots. There were 177 unresolved challenged ballots from 17 local lodges.

Schedule A below sets forth the total number of valid and void votes for all contested offices cast by members of IAM local lodges that submitted valid ballots and tallies. Schedule B below sets forth the votes cast for each of the candidates in each individual local lodge that participated in the election.

Based on the count and tabulation of all valid votes cast in the 2014 election, we hereby declare that the following members have been duly elected to the offices of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers for the term ending June 30, 2017 by virtue of having received the highest number of valid votes cast for the respective offices for which they ran. The successful candidates for General Vice President are listed in order of the number of votes received:




