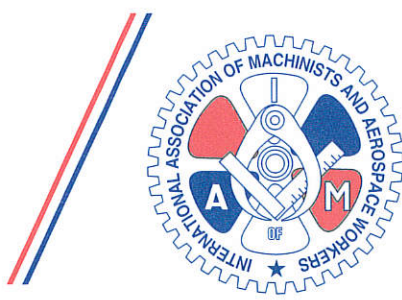

This letter will serve to announce the date for the 2015 Human Rights Training to be held May 31 – June 6, 2015 at the William W. Winpisinger Education and Technology Center in Hollywood, Maryland.

In our continuing commitment to civil and human rights for all IAM members throughout the United States and Canada, I strongly urge all lodges to participate in the aforementioned Human Rights training.

The training provides practical information and guidance on how to establish a viable human rights committee and ensure it operates in a proactive measure. Participants will utilize strategies to combat common civil and human rights violations such as bullying, discrimination and harassment.

The curriculum for this basic class was designed to provide a greater understanding of human rights issues and to promote invaluable discussion among the participants. We believe that the opportunity to exchange ideas, strategize, share experiences and build a communication network is a powerful tool in the hands of a union activist.
