ISAP Detailed Talking Points

1. ISAP is ICE's Intensive Supervision Appearance Program (ISAP)
 - Professionally run program that has been managed by BI Inc. (BI) for nearly 20 years
 - Provides effective and humane supervision of non-detained non-citizens
 - Consists of electronic monitoring and case management services
 - Also includes humanitarian services (e.g., housing, food and healthcare assistance)
2. IAM recently began organizing approx. 300 ISAP employees as new NFFE members
 - Plan to target an additional approx. 1,000 employees in coming weeks / months
 - Anticipate continuing to add NFFE jobs as ISAP grows in the future
3. ISAP has a track record of delivering excellent results for ICE on immigration compliance
 - 98% success rate for participants who remain in ISAP for the duration of their case
4. ICE has recently been releasing participants from ISAP before their case is over
 - Participant count peaked approx. 383,000 in Q4 2022, now at approx. 210,000
 - BI believes these reductions are due to ICE budgetary constraints
 - Early participant releases increase absconctions, making ISAP falsely look ineffective
5. ISAP can be optimized through enhanced use of individual participant "step down" phases
 - Participants would be moved into lower cost phases as they demonstrate compliance
 - Would enable all key non-detained migrant groups to be monitored safely and humanely
 - This approach can all be implemented within the existing A TD budget
6. Optimization of ISAP also can increase humanitarian assistance provided to participants
 - BI already works with many NGOs to provide relocation, food and medical assistance
 - Prominent NGOs include LSS, Bethany Christian Services, IILA, Ser Familia
 - BI can subcontract additional extended case management services to these NGOs
 - By-far lowest cost alternative (daily cost to ICE of \$4.39 vs. \$142.45 per detention bed)
7. ISAP equipment is cutting edge, safe and humane. There are 4 types of equipment in use:
 - BI-issued locked phones, which are minimally invasive and easy to use
 - Participant's own phone through BI mobile app (also minimally invasive and easy to use)
 - BI's own wrist-worn GPS device, which can be removable or nonremovable
 - Ankle-worn GPS device (less than 5,000 in use (less than 2% of the ISAP population))
8. There have been a number of false narratives about ISAP in the media that have been debunked
 - No ISAP participant has ever been burned / harmed by a BI device
 - ISAP does not charge participants in the program, ISAP is 100% U.S. taxpayer funded
 - BI does not sell or otherwise commercialize any ISAP participant data
 - All ISAP data is owned and controlled by ICE / Federal Government
 - BI only provides ISAP participant data to law enforcement agencies at ICE's instruction

9. ISAP provides critical humanitarian services to participants while their case is pending:

- Human Trafficking Screening and Group Education
- Child Abuse Prevention
- Family / Individual Therapy
- Rehabilitation

10. ISAP is THE ideal solution to the so-called "Open Border" dilemma

- It is a win-win across the board
- Allows Executive Branch to state all key migrant groups are being humanely monitored
- Gives Congress confidence that the program is effective and a good use of taxpayer funds
- Provides participants a structured vehicle to receive humanitarian aid / assistance
- Gives NGOS a continued vital role in carrying out their mission
- Does not require any increase in ATD funding or any amendment to the ISAP contract
