IAM UNION URGES THE SENATE TO PASS THE PROTECT AMERICA'S WORKFORCE ACT

Position: The IAM Union, which includes our 110,000-member affiliate National Federation of Federal Employees (NFFE-IAM), is urging the Senate to consider and pass the Protect America's Workforce Act (H.R. 2550 / S. 2837). **This bipartisan piece of legislation, also known as PAWA, already passed the U.S. House with a 231-195 vote, which included support from 20 Republicans who voted in favor of passage in the chamber.**

- The bill, introduced in the Senate by Sen. Mark Warner (D-VA) and in the U.S. House by Reps. Jared Golden (D-ME) and Brian Fitzpatrick (R-PA), would reverse the EO *Exclusions from the Federal Labor-Management Relations Programs*, which removes collective bargaining rights from 75 percent of the federal workforce.
- This EO is an assault on the rights and job security for federal workers caring for our veterans, keeping our military ready, adjudicating passport applications, caring for our public lands, and performing countless other essential public services.
- These workers deserve the right of collective bargaining, which provides protections in the workplace and better service to the public, just to name a few benefits.
