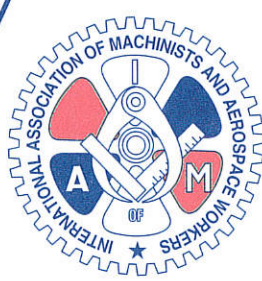
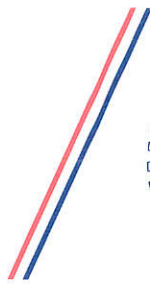

June 11 -16, 2017

To all Recording Secretaries of Local Lodges and Secretary-Treasurers of District Lodges in the United States and Canada

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

“Where, after all, do universal human rights begin? In small places, close to home – so close and so small that they cannot be seen on any maps of the world. Yet they are the world of the individual person; the neighborhood he lives in; the school or college he attends; the factory, farm or office where he works. Such are the places where every man, woman and child seeks equal justice, equal opportunity, equal dignity without discrimination. Unless these rights have meaning there, they have little meaning anywhere.”

Eleanor Roosevelt spoke those words in 1958 while advocating for a Universal Declaration of Human Rights. They are as relevant today as they were almost 60 years ago and have been part of our union’s core values for over 125 years. Unfortunately we’re still seeking true equality in our neighborhoods, schools and workplaces, which will only be realized when we all work together.

As a commitment to forward progress and our human rights program, the IAM will host the 2017 Human Rights Training at the IAM Winpisinger Center June 11<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>. Participants will learn techniques to spark change back home.
