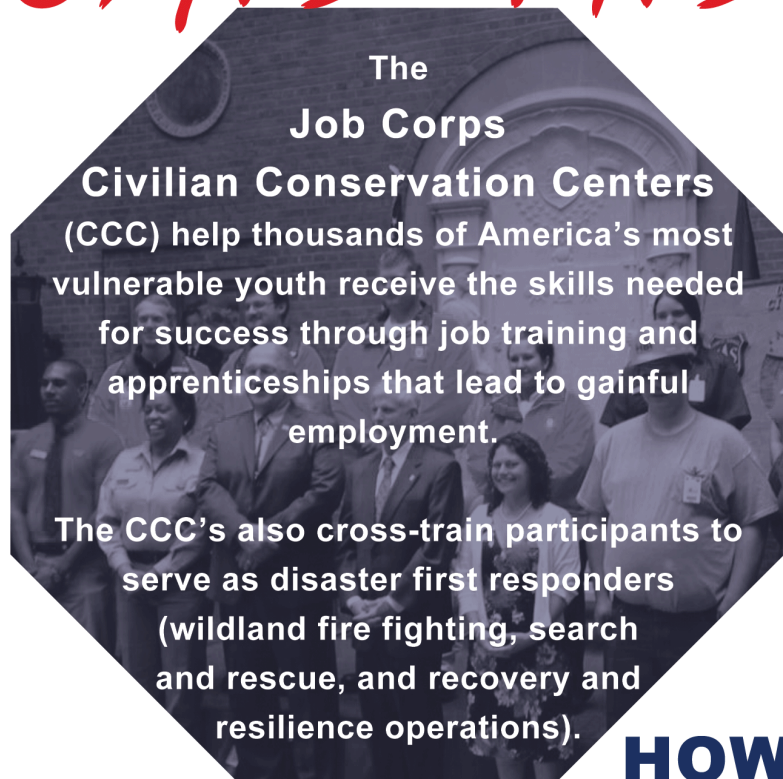

Golconda Job Corps has transformed thousands of high-risk young people into skilled workers with a future and financial security.

Participants are cross-trained as disaster first responders. At a time when the nation is fighting massive wildfires and three major hurricanes.

Centers teach disadvantaged youth important trades (carpentry, welding, masonry, electrical, medical support billing and painting) to build careers.

The city of Golconda, population less than 800, will suffer greatly if local jobs disappear; the Center brings as much as \$4 million each year to the region.
