

Subj: Women's Basic Training February 18-23, 2018

To all Recording Secretaries of Local Lodges and Secretary-Treasurers of District Lodges in the United States and Canada

Dear Brothers and Sisters:

From the Suffragist Movement of the late 1800's to the Women's Liberation Movement of the late 1960's, surely our foremothers expected by 2017 equality would have been achieved. Sadly, it has not. It's true that we've come a long way, but the journey isn't over.

The crumbling of social barriers and progress in the legislative arena is largely due to the demands of many through collective action. While the Labor Movement can't claim to have done it alone, we've always been at the forefront of the battle. The fact remains union membership is the most reliable way to ensure equal pay and access to forward mobility.

If we are to gain ground in the fight for gender equality, we need to have strong women as leaders. The Women's and Human Rights Department has developed two classes that are a step on the pathway to union leadership. The first class, Women's Basic Program will be held February 18 – February 23, 2018. This program will cover women's labor history and current women and family issues.

The second class is the Women's Advanced Program which will take place October 21 – October 26, 2018. This program is designed for members who have completed the Women's Basic Program and want to expand their skills as a female leader and activist in the labor movement.
