Dear Senator:

On behalf of the 600,000 active and retired members of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM Union), I write today in opposition of the nominations of Crystal Carey to serve as General Counsel of the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB), in addition to Scott Mayer and James Murphy to serve as Members of the NLRB. The IAM strongly opposes the Senate taking any action regarding this slate of nominees prior to NLRB member Gwynne Wilcox being reinstated.

As I've stated before, the IAM urges President Donald Trump to reverse the unprecedented and illegal firing of NLRB member Wilcox, restore the Board's independence, and protect workers' rights.

The IAM is a supporter of workers' rights and the importance of a functioning NLRB. The NLRB, with Board members from both political parties, is crucial to the rights of our nation's private-sector workforce, and without this balance, enforcement of the National Labor Relations Act cannot occur in a fair or impartial way. Because of this, we oppose any Senate consideration of the NLRB designates prior to the reinstatement of Wilcox, who was reconfirmed by this chamber in September 2023 by a bipartisan vote for a term ending August 27, 2028.
