Dear Mr. McDonald,

We are writing regarding Dana Inc.'s decision to permanently close its Robinson, Illinois automotive gasket manufacturing facility and the resulting loss of employment for 69 workers and their families.

For nearly six decades, the Robinson facility has been an important employer and economic anchor in Crawford County. The workers at this plant have dedicated years—and in many cases entire careers—to helping build Dana Inc.'s success. Their commitment, skill, and hard work deserve recognition and respect during this transition.


While we recognize the challenges companies face in an evolving economy, we are deeply concerned about the impact this closure will have on the affected workers, their families, and the broader Robinson community. As Dana Inc. moves forward with this decision, we urge the company to engage in meaningful and good-faith effects bargaining with the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAM) to ensure employees receive fair treatment and the support they deserve.

We encourage Dana Inc. to work collaboratively with union representatives to provide a comprehensive transition package that includes strong benefits for eligible workers, including ongoing support for employees seeking transfer opportunities at other Dana Inc. or IAM-represented facilities.


The men and women of this facility have helped sustain Dana Inc.'s operations for generations. They deserve a transition process that reflects their years of service and contributions to the company.
